
How to select a book for the one-year-old?

Brain research with very young children, 12 months to 24 months, has shown that this age group learns and responds best from materials that contain the following—

- 1. are repetitious
- 2. are simple in content
- 3. are rhythmic and rhyme
- 4. have recognizable, realistic characters
- 5. contain likeable characters
- 6. have clear, uncluttered backgrounds
- 7. use basic colors
- 8. are easily identifiable
- 9. are memorable and enjoyable
- 10. have characters surrounded by plenty of white space in order to focus
- 11. provides an opportunity for kinesthetic experiences
- 12. length accommodates the child's attention span
